

My U.S. ATA One-Page Exhibits

Type, Purpose, and Scope

This 16-page single-frame topical exhibit focuses on the 14 American Topical Association (ATA) U.S. one-page exhibits I have put together over a five-year period from the very beginning in 2021 through 2025. The topics covered range from superheroes to lighthouses to history to art to whatever strikes my fancy at the time. All of the exhibits are focused on U.S. stamps and many show a stamp series. The one-page exhibits are shown in chronological fashion from 2021 to 2025. They could have been arranged in topical order but chronological shows the evolution of the pages.

The idea behind the one-page exhibits was to encourage people to develop an exhibit to show off their stamps or covers. The exhibits are shown online only in pdf format and are non-competitive. The rules have been adjusted over the years to include 11x17 pages and require names. Up to five exhibits can be done by a person in a given year. I have covered my name on the pages for the purpose of this 16-page exhibit, but otherwise each page is exactly as I submitted it.
